Earliest days: (early 80's)



(late 80's early 90's)

After the ET's wound down, I found myself filling in for a missing member in Jon South's band at the time, a short lived excersise in futility, which eventually saw both Jon and myself walking out, and starting again, drafting in my then wife Sue (bass), and mutual friend Greg Altina (vocals), into a new band (needing only a drummer)...

With the quick addition of Foolish Paul Atikin (drums), and a swapping of roles between Greg and Sue, the VOGON's were born, calling Moonlight Studios in Brookvale our new home, and playing a mix of poppy originals and re-worked covers at parties and special events from late 80's thru into early 90's.
